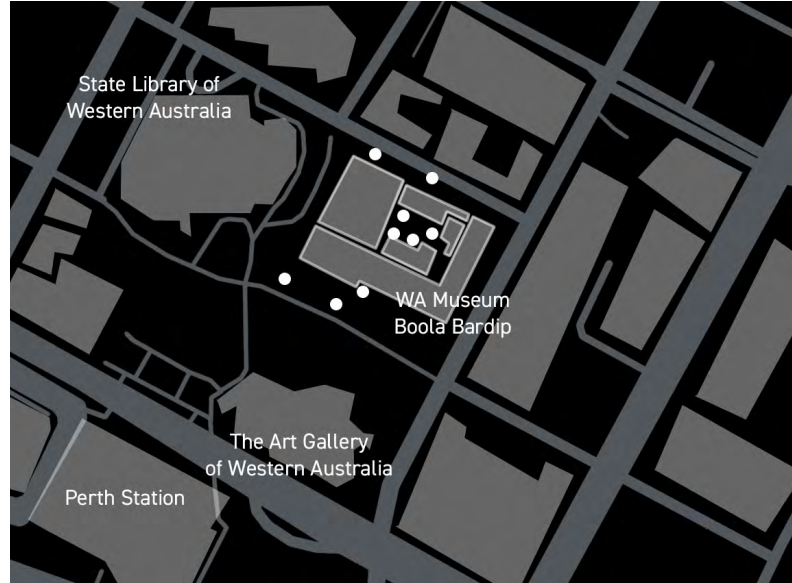


WA MUSEUM BOOLA BARDIP
